Finding Hope in Pennsylvania

Tayleen, a former Marine, had been pregnant with triplets and sadly lost them at 25 weeks. She and her husband were devastated. The following year, she was pregnant again and felt afraid due to her experience. "It was hard because anytime I felt any type of stomach pain, it made me very paranoid," she shared, "and so I started looking on my phone to see what type of services I could find that would help me confirm the pregnancy. And that's when Align came up."

Tayleen remembers how special it was when she first went to Align Pregnancy Services: "For me to go into that appointment and hear my baby's heartbeat for the first time, I just started shedding tears because to be in a position after everything we've been through, it was just like a magical moment is how it felt."

Tayleen formed a strong bond with her client advocate Kristin and the Align team, particularly during prenatal education classes and parenting classes after her daughter was born. Her husband also attended the classes. "The people here at Align, they really are like family," explained Tayleen. "They check up on me. They love seeing my daughter, and I love bringing her to see them." Align also helped restore Tayleen's faith in God. "I enjoy every week that I get to spend with Kristin, and we received a lot of answered prayers throughout my pregnancy and my time here at Align. And it's helping me open up my faith and give my heart to God." She reflected, "God met me in my pain that I had from losing them [her triplets] by giving me Vanessa."

NOTES:

- This report is a collaborative project between Charlotte Lozier Institute (CLI) and Care Net. We are grateful to Heartbeat International and the National Institute of Family and Life Advocates for their contributions towards data collection from their affiliated U.S. pregnancy centers.
- Value of services is based upon materials and services provided by 130 pregnancy centers in the state of Pennsylvania in calendar year 2022. At least 12 of the centers reporting data received state or federal funding in 2022.
- Total savings are calculated based on cost estimates of services, classes and baby items provided to clients. The sources for the cost estimates and valuation of items and services can be found in the Methodology section, pgs. 15-16, of the 2022 CLI national pregnancy center report, "Hope for A New Generation" (<https://lozierinstitute.org/pcr/>), except for the following state-specific labor costs.
- The Pennsylvania mean hourly wages referenced are as follows: Social Workers in local/state government is \$32.88 per hour - BLS OES code 21-1029, Registered Nurses is \$42.08 per hour - OES code 29-1141, and Diagnostic Medical Sonographers is \$39.79 per hour - OES code 29-2032.
- The estimated savings does not include housing and other monetary assistance provided to some clients. We advocate for our clients by networking with hundreds of county, state and non-profit social service organizations around the country. We cannot quantify the value of emotional support given to the women we help through phone calls and caring volunteers.
